AROMATIC, CRISP, REFRESHING

LOLA Rosé of Pinot Noir is 100% pinot noir from our younger vines in Northern California Coast. The grapes were picked slightly under-ripe and lightly crushed by foot, then pressed off the skins after 4 hours. The wine is vibrant, with a light pink color and aromas of strawberry, candied peach and watermelon. Its bright acidity and crispiness on the palate makes it a perfect wine for summer days, and a wonderful pairing to vegetables and seafood.
