RIPE STRAWBERRY, FRESH CEDAR, SOFT

LOLA Russian River Pinot Noir is a blend of Dijon clone 115 and a clone brought back from Vosne Romanée by our winemaker, years ago, both of which are planted at our Bloomfield Road Vineyard in the Russian River Valley. Deep garnet in color, this wine has the aromas of fresh, wild strawberry, cherry, red current and a hint of vanilla bean, complimented by notes of cedar and cinnamon. Refreshing acidity and delicate tannins reveal themselves in the long finish.
