LOLA Rosé of Pinot Noir is 100% pinot noir from our younger vines in Mendocino and Sonoma Coast. The grapes were picked slightly under-ripe and lightly crushed by foot, then pressed off the skins after 8 hours. The wine is vibrant, with bright pink color and aromas of cherry and guava. Its bright acidity and crispness on the palate makes it a perfect wine for warm summer days, and a wonderful pairing to vegetables and seafood.
