### RIPE STRAWBERRY, FRESH CEDAR, SOFT

LOLA Russian River Pinot Noir is a blend of Dijon clones 115 and 777, and a suitcase clone from Vosne Romanée, France, brought back by our winemaker in 2005; all of which are planted at our Bloomfield Road Vineyard in the Russian River Valley AVA. The wine is deep garnet in color with aromas of fresh wild strawberry, cherry, red currants and forest floor accented by notes of vanilla, cedar and cinnamon. On the palate, the wine's bright acidity and supple texture is accompanied by delicate tannins and a long, lingering finish.
